

ORDINANCE 1995-2

An Ordinance approving the extension of curfew for certain areas located in the City of Turrell, Arkansas.

WHEREAS, the City of Turrell, Arkansas has, by previously duly enacted and adopted resolutions and ordinances, established curfews for the City of Turrell, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, the commercial district on Highway 77 warrants an extension of that curfew time; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that it is in the best interest of the residents of Turrell, Arkansas, to so extend the curfew so as to accommodate the need of new businesses locating on said highway and to induce other business to locate there;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

1. As to the curfews for commercial development located along Highway 77 in the City of Turrell, Arkansas, the following curfew is established: Sunday through Saturday until 12:00 a.m. (Midnight).

2. These extended curfew hours are only adopted for the commercial businesses located now, or in the future, along Highway 77 in Turrell, Arkansas.


3. Any and all prior ordinances and/or resolutions of the City of Turrell to the contrary are hereby repealed.
