**AN ORDINANCE LIMITING PARKING IN THE CITY STREETS
OF THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS**

WHEREAS, The greatly increased use by the public of motor vehicles of all kinds has caused serious traffic congestion on the Streets of the City of Turrell, Arkansas, and the practice of parking motor vehicles on the Streets and leaving the same over night have contributed to this congestion to such an extent as to interfere seriously with the primary use of such Streets for the movement of traffic; and,

WHEREAS, In the opinion of the City Council it would be to the best interest of the City that there be enacted an Ordinance which limits the practice of parking on the street within the Corporate Limits of the City of Turrell;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any owner, occupant, resident, or overnight visitor to any house or residence in the Corporate Limits of the City of Turrell to park or leave any motor vehicle or trailer belonging to such person or persons on the Streets or Alleys of the City of Turrell during the hours of 1 A.M. to 5 A.M. of each day, except at such places as shall have been designated as permitted overnight parking places by the City Council of Turrell, Arkansas.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, and each separate day of such occurrence shall be considered a separate offense.

Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. The congested condition of parking areas and the consequent

practice of parking along the Streets of Turrell, due to unlimited parking has resulted in a serious traffic hazard, which is dangerous to motor vehicle operators. An emergency is herefor declared and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
