AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION, SALE OR USE OF ANY PYROTECHNICS, (FIREWORKS) IN THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, association, firm or corporation within the corporate limits of the City to possess for resale purposes or to sell at retail, any pyrotechnics, commonly known as "fireworks".

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use, ignite or shoot any pyrotechnics, commonly known as "fireworks" in or on the sidewalks, streets, or in or on any public or private business place in the corporate limits of the City of Turrell. Provided, however, that it shall not be considered a violation of this Ordinance for any person or persons to use, ignite or shoot any fireworks on the premises of the property owned, or otherwise occupied by them as their home or personal residence.

SECTION 3. Any person, partnership, association, firm or corporation which shall possess for resale purposes or sell at retail within the corporate limits of the City of Turrell any pyrotechnics shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and for each such offense may be fined any sum up to \$500.00. If said offense is a continuing offense, then the fine for the first day's offense shall be not more than \$250.00, and not more than \$250.00 for each subsequent day that said offense continues.

SECTION 4. If any person or persons shall use, ignite or shoot any pyrotechnics in the City limits of the City of Turrell in, on or about any place other than such places where the same is permitted by Section 2. above, then such offense shall be a misdemeanor and for each such offense may be fined in an amount not to exceed \$250.00.

SECTION 5. If for any reason, any portion of this Ordinance

shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions thereof which shall be valid, but such valid portions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance and the provisions thereof shall become effective on and after its adoption.
